## CHAPTER XVI

# CONSULTATIVE ARRANGEMENTS WITH NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS

### GRANTING OF CONSULTATIVE STATUS

Eleven applications and re-applications from non-governmental organizations (NGO's) for consultative status with the Economic and Social Council were considered during 1957, at the Council's twenty-third session, held between 16 April and 2 May. On the basis of a report from the Council Committee on Non-Governmental Organizations, the Council decided, on 25 April, to grant category B consultative status to the International Commission of Jurists. It decided not to grant the requests of the following organizations for category B consultative status: International Association of Democratic Lawyers and the International Organization of Journalists. It asked that the following organizations be placed on the Register of NGO's: American Foreign Insurance Association (U.S.A.), Comité d'études économiques de l'industrie du gaz, European Bureau for Youth and Childhood, and the International Federation of Cotton and Allied Textile Industries.

The Council decided not to grant the requests of the following organizations for re-classification from the Register to category B: International Federation of Independent Air Transport and the World Federation of Democratic Youth. It also decided not to place the European Union of Accountants on the Register.

Deferred until 1958 was consideration of the

application of the International Confederation of Senior Public Servants for category B consultative status.

### OPERATING CONSULTATIVE ARRANGEMENTS

#### WRITTEN STATEMENTS FROM NGO'S

Sixty-four written statements by 39 NGO's were submitted during 1957 to the Economic and Social Council or to the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF), or to the Council's Commissions and their subsidiaries. The Commissions to which statements were directed were: the Transport and Communications Commission, the Population Commission, the Social Commission, the Commission on Human Rights, the Commission on the Status of Women, and the Economic Commission for Asia and the Far East. Written statements were also sent to the Sub-Commission on the Prevention of Discrimination and Protection of Minorities and to UNICEF.

#### HEARING OF NGO'S

During the Council's twenty-third session, the following NGO's with category A consultative status made statements on various items on the Council's agenda, as indicated.
